Dear Researcher,

Horticulturists and researchers in related sciences are invited to submit research proposals for funding by Floriculture Industry Research and Scholarship Trust. Deadline for submissions is September 1, of each **year.** FIRST has a policy of not funding overhead or travel expenses.

For over 20 years, the Bedding Plants Foundation, Inc. and Ohio Floriculture Foundation have funded research projects at universities throughout the U.S. and Canada. These two charitable organizations have merged to form FIRST. We fund approximately \$100,000 in research grants each year.

All grant recipients are required to submit progress reports twice a year, on June 1 and December 1, for the board to review at the July and January meetings. Final reports are published and sent to all FIRST contributors and those who request information.

A survey of growers indicated the following research opportunities in our mission to improve the production and marketability of plants:

- Increasing self life/garden performance
- Economical means for recycling greenhouse waste

- Water quality/alkalinity control
- Evaluation/development of biocontrol methods and management techniques
- Improving production techniques
- Plug production techniques
- Perennial production techniques
- Control of pest problems such as: thrips, aphids, whitefly, fungus gnats
- Control of disease problems such as: TSWV, botrytis, mildew, pythium

Application for Research Project Funding

Include the completed form with the detailed explanation of your request or proposal (not to exceed ten (10) pages.) If project is expected to extend past one year and can be measured in phases, show your anticipated schedule for phase completion and progress reporting.

- Proposals must be received by September 1 for consideration before the November Board Meeting of FIRST.
- It is not the policy of FIRST to fund administrative costs.
- If a grant is awarded, a research progress report is required June 1 and December 1 each year until a final research report is submitted. Final Reports are to be submitted in popular format to be published by FIRST.
- Grant durations are one year. Renewal requests are given primary consideration. Researchers must submit their requests annually. To fail to submit progress reports or to change the project without prior approval of the FIRST Board is cause for rejecting a renewal request.
