Directions:

- Remove the lid of the provided "IPM Cleaner Solution" spray bottle.
- 2. Pour in liquid dish detergent to the 2 oz. line at bottom of bottle.
- 3. Add water to the 30 oz. line at top of bottle.
- 4. Replace lid and shake gently.
- 5. Clean up insects.

Sprayed surfaces may be slippery when wet. Never use "IPM Cleaner Solution" to clean up wasp, yellow jacket, or bee nests.
